② Your Availability

— CV (optional): Feel free to include your CV, highlighting any experiences or interests relevant to the arts and culture sector.

③ Your Personal Circumstances (optional) 250 words max or 2-3 minutes in a voice note or video

Please outline any barriers you feel you have experienced that have impacted on your ability to develop a career in the arts. For example, this might include information on your cultural or socio economic background, or details of any access needs in relation to the role, application process or interview. Only share what feels comfortable.

④ Your Creativity

Share something you have created or have been a part of creating. This could be an artwork or exhibition, a performance, poetry or a written review, or even a recipe! Feel free to include images or links to your work.

Share a short explanation of the work and your involvement in it.

⑤ Your Motivation

(250 words max or 2-3 minutes in a voice note or video)

Explain why you want to be part of the Southall Curatorship. How will you contribute to the curatorship, and what do you hope to learn?

⑥ Your Vision

(250 words max or 2-3 minutes in a voice note or video)

Propose an idea for a cultural event or project in Southall and/or the Borough of Ealing, explaining why this would be a good fit for the area. This could be an event, exhibition, digital project, workshop, talk or live performance. Think about where this would take place and who your target audience would be. Be as imaginative as you like!
